Limitation of duties of the holder of the Honorary Consulate in Denpasar (Indonesia)

THE DIRECTOR GENERAL FOR ITALIANS ABROAD AND MIGRATORY POLICIES (Omissis);

Decrees:

Mr. Alessandro Tanganelli, Honorary Consul in Denpasar (Indonesia), in addition to carrying out the general duties of defending national interests and protecting Italian citizens, shall exercise consular functions limited to:

- a) reception and material transmission to the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta of civil status documents received from local authorities and Italian citizens or from commanders of national or foreign vessels or aircrafts;
- b) reception and material transmission to the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta of declarations concerning civil status by commanders of vessels and aircrafts, or by witnesses;
- c) reception and material transmission to the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta of wills made on board of vessels and aircrafts by Italian citizens;
- d) receipt and material transmission to the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta of the documentation necessary for the issuance of preventive measures, not involving the disposition of assets, in matters of inheritance, shipwreck or air accident;
- e) receipt and material transmission to the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta of applications, presented by citizens who are resident in the territorial jurisdiction of the Honorary Consular Office, for the recording of acts in the registry and in the electoral register in Italy;
- f) notification of documents to Italian citizens residing in the territorial jurisdiction of the Honorary Office, informing the competent Italian authority the result thereof as well as the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta;
- g) receipt and transmission to the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta of documents concerning the issuance of passports to Italian citizens who reside in the territorial jurisdiction of the Honorary Consular Office;
- h) receipt and transmission to the Italian Embassy in Jakarta of documentation pertaining to applications for the issuance of a temporary travel document (ETD) submitted by Italian citizens and citizens of EU member states, after receiving the report of the loss or theft of a passport or other travel document and after conducting the appropriate verifications required under Article 71 of Presidential Decree No. 445 of December 28, 2000, regarding the accuracy of the statutory declarations referred to in Articles 46 and 47 of the aforementioned Presidential Decree; issuance of ETDs issued by the Italian Embassy in Jakarta, valid for a single journey to the EU Member State of which the applicant is a citizen, to the country of permanent residence, or, exceptionally, to another destination.
- i) administrative authentication of signatures, in cases provided by law;
- j) delivery of certificates issued by the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta;
- k) certification of life existence for pension purposes;
- l) endorsements and legalizations;
- m) authentication of signatures on private agreements, drafting of affidavits on behalf of Italian citizens concerning natural persons, in cases provided by law;
- n) collaboration with the Embassy of Italy in Jakarta in the update of the register of Italian citizens residing in the consular district;

o) maintenance of the register of Italian citizens residing in the consular district and of the register of local authority signatures.

This Decree shall be published in the Official Gazette of the Italian Republic.
